

Biking Otavalo - 3.100mts



Otavalo Valley is located north of Quito, at the foot of "Taita Imbabura" Volcano, it is surrounded by lakes and hills covered with incredible green carpets of cornfields. Otavalo is known worldwide as one of the largest indigenous markets in Latin America.

After breakfast, we will head north on the Pan-American highway towards Otavalo city crossing indigenous villages, enjoying amazing sceneries and a wonderful view of Lake San Pablo and Peguche's waterfall. There will be some traffic on the starting point.

Cycling will start on a 3rd order road following an old train route Cayambe - Otavalo.

We will ride on dirt and rocks routes. The ride will cover 35 km of incredible vegetation cycling will end at the market. Lunch. Return to Quito in the afternoon.
